# BUSHEL OF APPLES MINI

**FINISHED QUILT SIZE 20" x 20"**

**Finished Block Size 6" x 6"**

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

⅛ yard (15 cm) white main (C5450 White)

⅛ yard (15 cm) red picnic (C5451 Red)

⅛ yard (15 cm) green fresh (C5452 Green)

⅛ yard (15 cm) red fresh (C5452 Red)

¼ yard (25 cm) white fresh (C5452 White)

⅛ yard (15 cm) yellow plaid (C5453 Yellow)

⅛ yard (15 cm) green chickadee (C5454 Green)

⅛ yard (15 cm) pink chickadee (C5454 Pink)

⅛ yard (15 cm) yellow chickadee (C5454 Yellow)

⅛ yard (15 cm) green blossom (C5455 Green)

¼ yard (25 cm) red blossom (C5455 Red)

⅛ yard (15 cm) brown daisy (C5456 Brown)

⅛ yard (15 cm) white daisy (C5456 White)

¼ yard (25 cm) cloud solid (C120 Cloud)

⅛ yard (15 cm) Riley brown solid (C120 Riley Brown)

Binding ¼ yard (25 cm)

Backing ¾ yard (70 cm)

## CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

### White Main

Cut 2 squares 2½" x 2½".

### Red Picnic

Cut 2 squares 2½" x 2½".

Cut 1 apple using the template provided. Add a ¼" seam allowance and reverse image if necessary for your favorite method of applique.

### Green Fresh

Cut 1 apple using the template provided. Add a ¼" seam allowance and reverse image if necessary for your favorite method of applique.

### Red Fresh

Cut 3 squares 2½" x 2½".

### White Fresh

Cut 2 strips 2½" x WOF for Border 2.

### Yellow Plaid

Cut 2 squares 2½" x 2½".

### Green Chickadee

Cut 2 squares 2½" x 2½".

### Pink Chickadee

Cut 2 squares 2½" x 2½".

### Yellow Chickadee

Cut 1 leaf using the template provided. Add a ¼" seam allowance and reverse image if necessary for your favorite method of applique.

### Green Blossom

Cut 2 squares 2½" x 2½".

### Red Blossom

Cut 2 strips 2½" x WOF for Border 1.

### Brown Daisy

Cut 2 squares 2½" x 2½".

Cut 1 leaf using the template provided. Add a ¼" seam allowance and reverse image if necessary for your favorite method of applique.

### White Daisy

Cut 1 square 2½" x 2½".

### Cloud Solid

Cut 2 squares 6½" x 6½".

### Riley Brown Solid

Cut 2 stems using the template provided. Add a ¼" seam allowance and reverse image if necessary for your favorite method of applique.

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to the quilt photo for placement of fabrics as each block is a different combination of fabrics.

### Nine-Patch Block

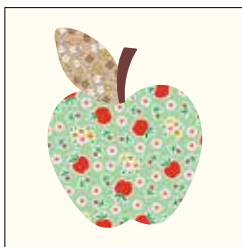
Sew 9 assorted print  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares together to complete the Nine-Patch Block. Repeat to create 2 assorted Nine-Patch Blocks.

### Apple Block

Use your favorite method of applique. Refer to quilt photo for placement of apples, leaves, and stem on cloud solid  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Make 2 Apple Blocks.

### Quilt Center Assembly

Lay out the Nine-Patch and Apple Blocks in 2 rows of 2 blocks. Sew the rows together to complete the center of the quilt.

### Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

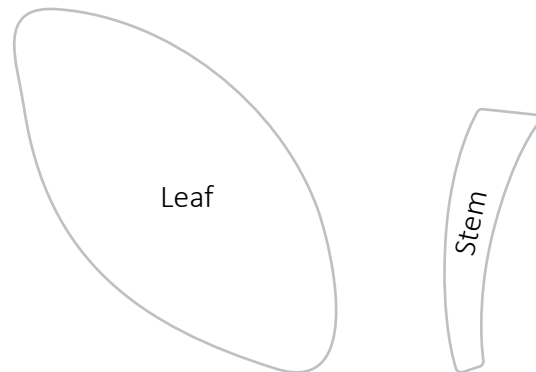
#### Border 1

Side borders should be  $12\frac{1}{2}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be  $16\frac{1}{2}$ ".

#### Border 2

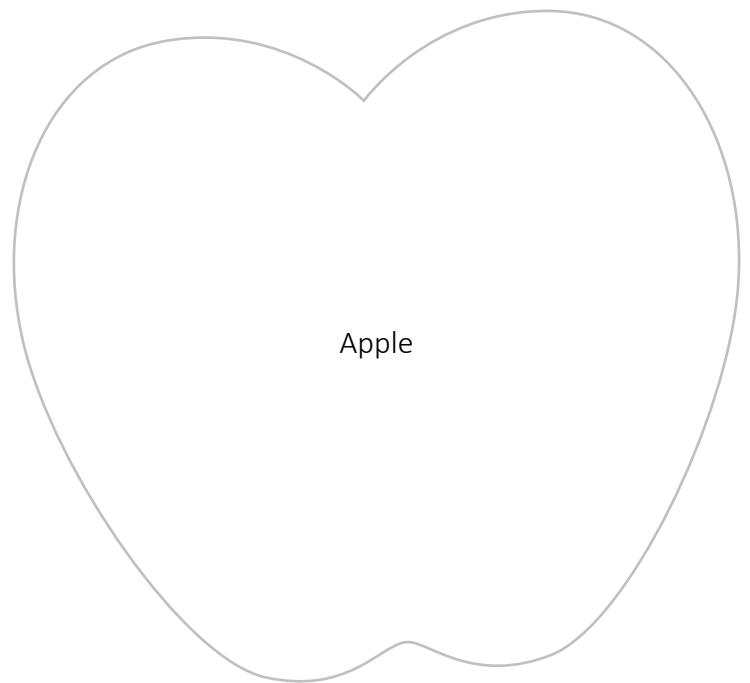
Side borders should be  $16\frac{1}{2}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be  $20\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Penny Rose fabric from the Apple Farm Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
