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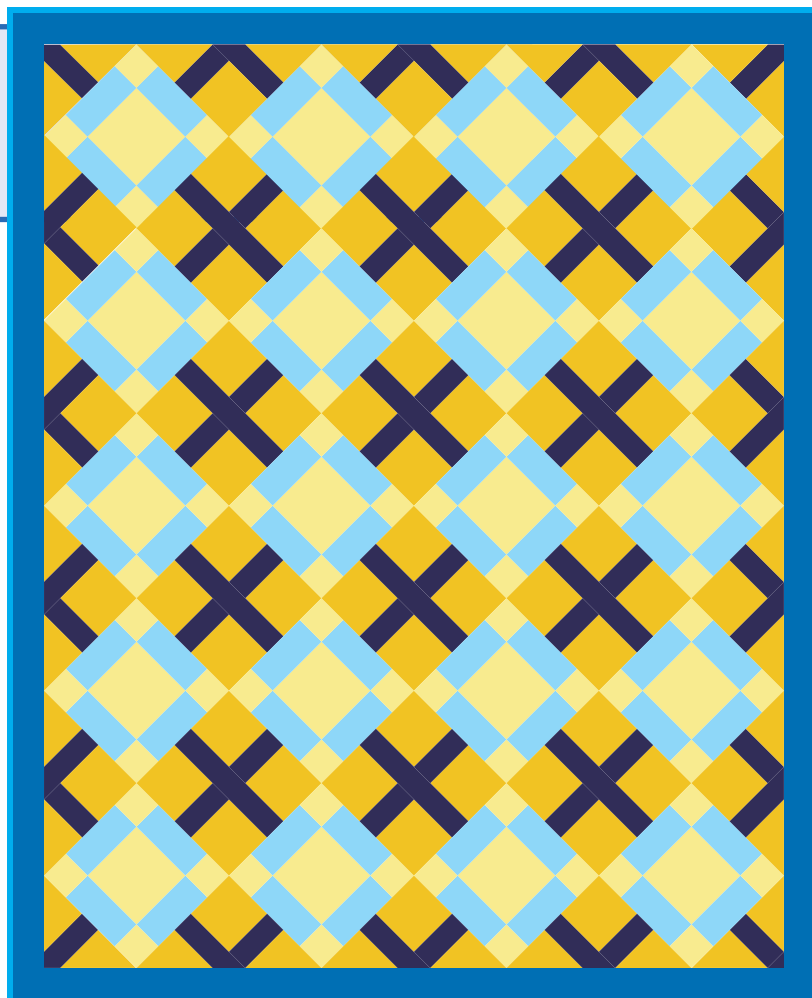
Pattern Basics

We encourage breaking the rules, but here are a few things you might want to keep in mind:







- Please read through all the instructions carefully before beginning a project. Every effort has been made to ensure the accuracy of this pattern.
- All instructions use a 1/4" seam allowance unless otherwise stated.

Common Quilting Acronyms:

FQ = fat quarter (18" x 22") WS = wrong side of fabric
 FE = fat eighth (18" x 11") RS = right side of fabric
 WOFQ = width of fat quarter HST = half square triangle
 WOF = width of fabric



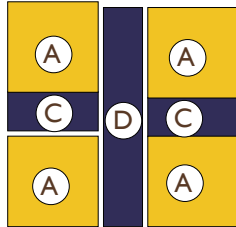
Approx. finished size: 52" x 64"

 1 1-1/2 yds	A - One hundred-twenty 4" squares	 4 1 yd	E - Twenty 5" squares F - Eighty 2-1/2" squares
 2 1 yd	B - Eighty 2-1/2" x 5" rectangles	 5 1-3/4 yds	G - Two 2-1/2" x 60-1/2" H - Two 2-1/2" x 52-1/2" <i>Always measure quilt before cutting borders</i>
 3 1 yd	C - Sixty 2" x 4" rectangles D - Thirty 2" x 9" rectangles	 6 1/2 yd	Binding - At least 242" of continuous 2" wide strips.

Directions

Block A:

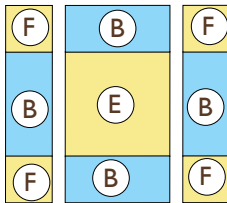
1. Sew **A**'s to opposite sides of **C** as shown.
2. Sew two **A/C/A** units to opposite sides of **D**. Make 30 blocks.



Make 30
9" square

Block B:

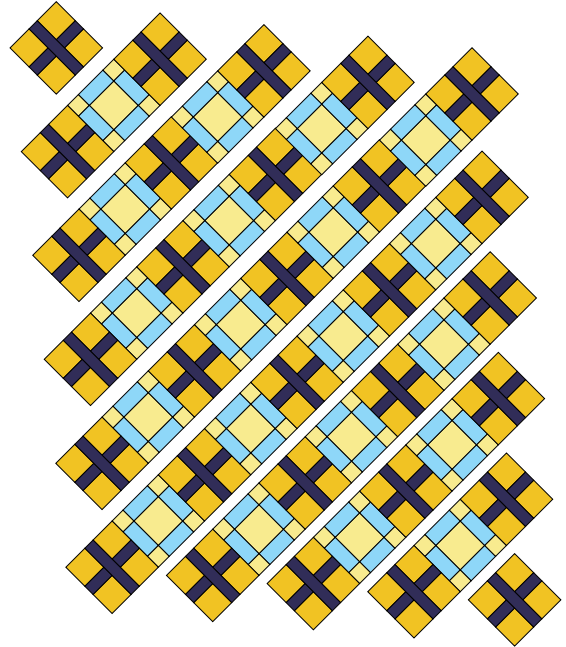
3. Sew **F**'s to opposite ends of **B**'s. Make 40.
4. Sew remaining **B**'s to opposite ends of **E**'s. Make 20.
5. Sew the **F/B/F** units to opposite sides of the **B/E/B** as shown.



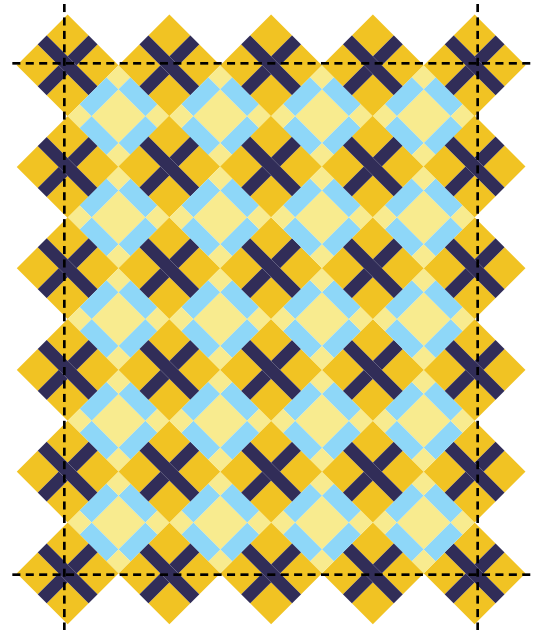
Make 20
9" square

Sew rows:

6. Alternate **Block A**'s and **Block B**'s beginning and ending with a **Block A**. Sew into rows as shown. Then sew these rows together.

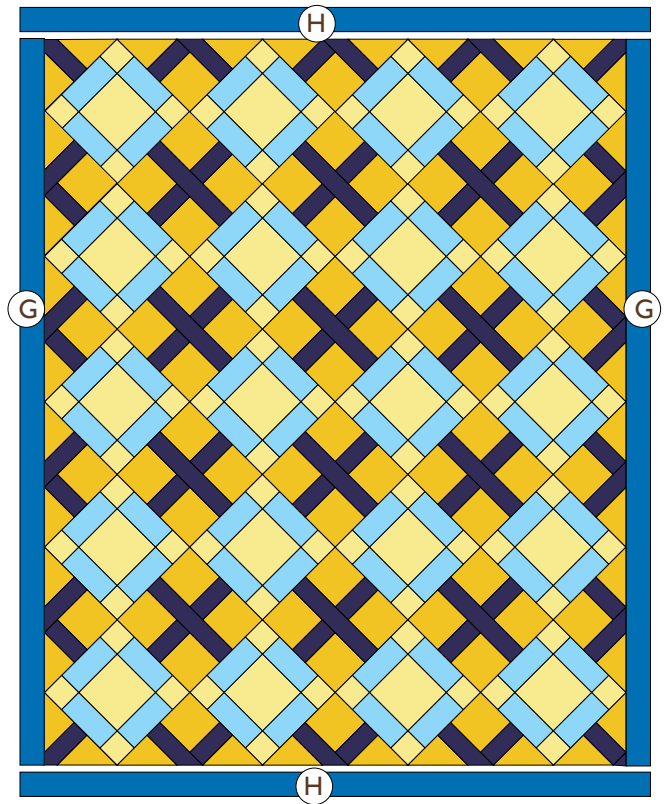


7. Trim outside **Block A**'s. Leave 1/4" seam allowance when cutting.



Borders:

8. Sew two **G**'s to opposite sides of the quilt top.
9. Sew the remaining two **H**'s to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
10. Layer backing, batting, and quilt top wrong sides together and quilt as desired.
11. Sew binding on using a 1/4" seam allowance.
