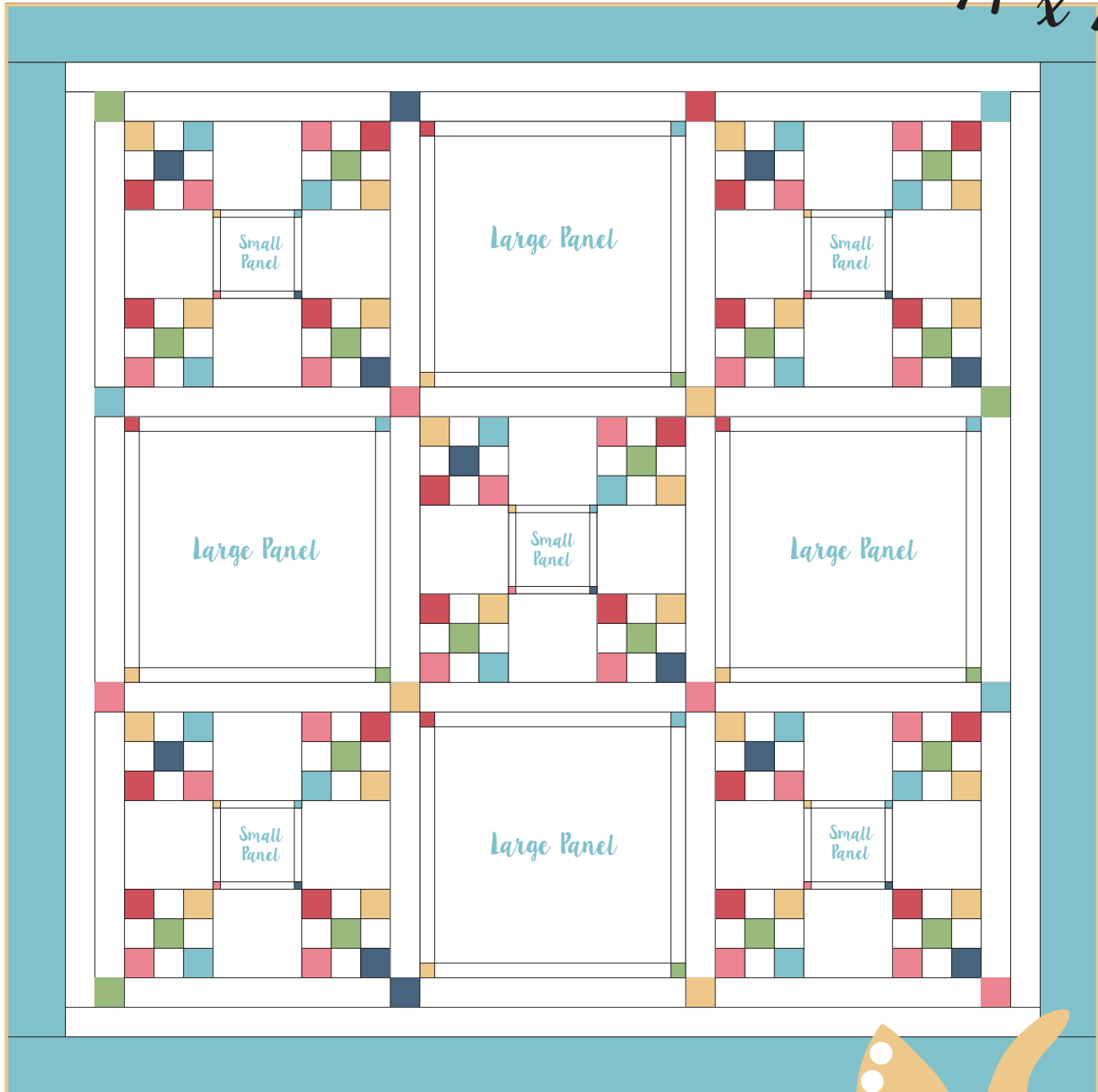

Fabric Requirements:

1- Lori Holt Flea Market Appliqué Panel
Print fabric: A variety of colored prints totaling: 1 yard
Background: Lori Holt Bee Backgrounds : 3 yards
Outer Border: 1 yard
Backing: 4 ½ yards
Binding: 1 yard

*If you do not want to use the Lori Holt Flea Market Appliqué panel you can substitute the panel blocks for quilt blocks measuring 16 ½" unfinished for the large panel, and 5 ½" unfinished for the small panel.

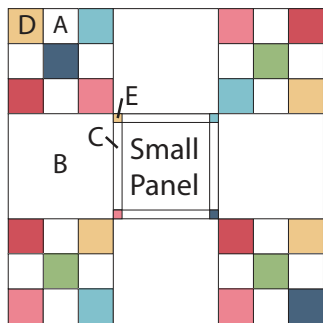

Block Instructions:

Nine Patch Block



Unfinished Block Size: 18 1/2" x 18 1/2"

Cutting Instructions:

A	80 - 2 1/2" squares
B	20 - 6 1/2" squares
C	20 - 5 1/2" x 1" rectangles
D	100 - 2 1/2" squares
E	20 - 1" squares

Small Panels:

Trim to 5 1/2" square

Make 5.

1. With right sides facing, assemble **Fabric A squares** to **Fabric D squares**. Then, assemble the rows together according to the diagram below to make a nine patch block. The unit should measure 6 1/2" square.



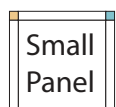
Make twenty.

2. With right sides facing, assemble **Fabric E squares** to each end of two **Fabric C rectangles**. Unit should measure 1" x 6 1/2."



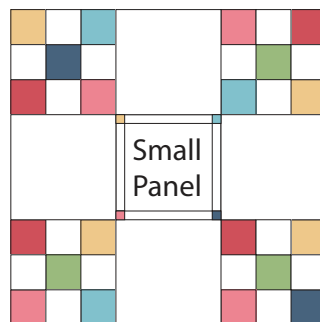
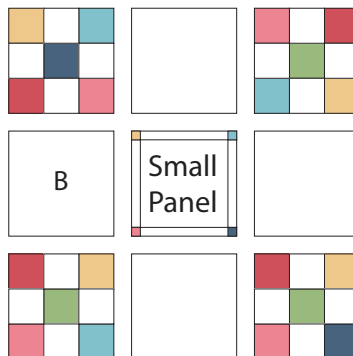
Make ten.

3. With right sides facing, assemble the remaining **Fabric C rectangles** to two sides of the **Small Fabric Panel**. Then assemble the units from **step 2** to the top and bottom of the small panel. Unit should measure 6 1/2" square.



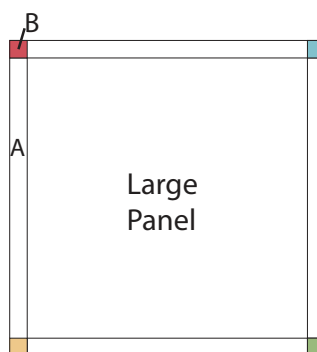
Make five.

4. Arrange the blocks according to the diagram below and assemble the rows. The block should measure 18 1/2" square.



Make five.

Large Panel Block



Unfinished Block Size: 18 1/2" x 18 1/2"

Cutting Instructions:

A	16 - 1 1/2" x 16 1/2" rectangles
B	16 - 1 1/2" squares

Large Panels:

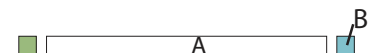
Trim to 16 1/2" square

Make 4.



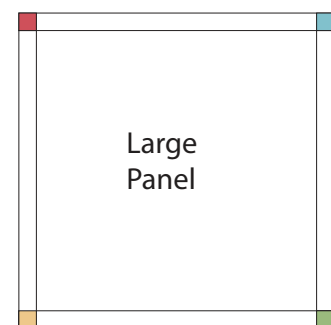
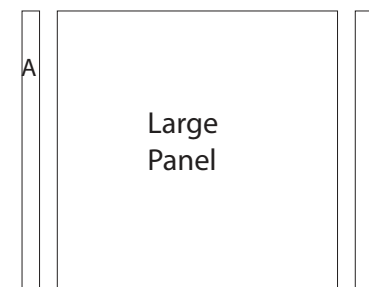
1. With right sides facing, assemble **Fabric B squares** to each end of two **Fabric A rectangles**.

Unit should measure 1" x 6 1/2."



Make eight.

2. With right sides facing, assemble the remaining **Fabric A rectangles** to two sides of the **Large Fabric Panel**. Then, assemble the units from **step 1** to the top and bottom of the large panel. Unit should measure 18 1/2" square.



Make four.

Cutting Instructions:

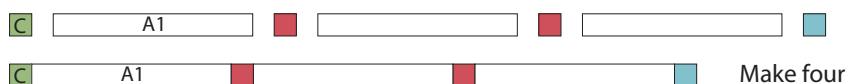
A	24 - 2 1/2" x 18 1/2" rectangles (A1 & A2)
B	7 - 2 1/2" x WOF strips (B1 & B2)
C	16 - 2 1/2" squares
D	7 - 4 1/2" x WOF strips (D1 & D2)

Binding: 8 - 2 1/2" x WOF strips

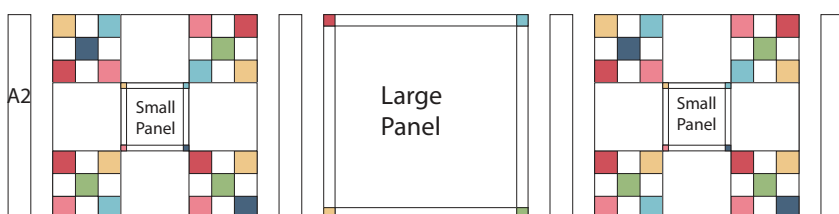


Sashing:

1. Assemble **Fabric C** to **Fabric A1** according to the diagram below. Press towards Fabric A1. Sashing should measure 62 1/2" x 2 1/2"

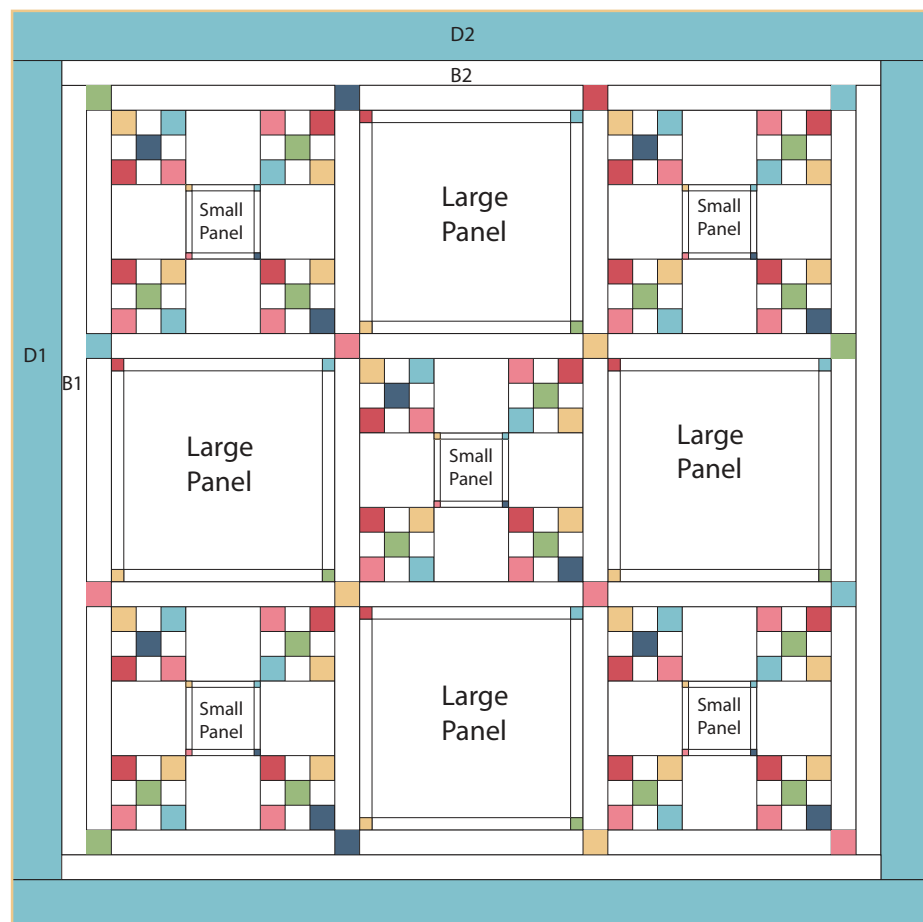


2. Assemble **Fabric A2** to the sides of the blocks. Reference the whole quilt layout below for additional rows. Press towards Fabric A2.



Block rows should measure 62 1/2" x 18 1/2"

Borders and Quilt Assembly:



3. Assemble **Fabric Strips B** together. Sub-cut into two 62 1/2" strips (**Border B1**). Sub-cut remaining fabric into two 66 1/2" strips (**Border B2**). * It is important to measure your quilt before you cut these strips, as your quilt may be slightly different.

4. Attach **border B1** to the sides of the quilt. Press. Attach **border B2** to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press.

5. Assemble **Fabric Strips D** together. Sub-cut into two 66 1/2" strips (**Border D1**). Sub-cut remaining fabric into two 74 1/2" strips (**Border D2**). * It is important to measure your quilt before you cut these strips, as your quilt may be slightly different.

6. Attach **border D1** to the sides of the quilt. Press. Attach **border D2** to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press.

Quilt should measure 74" x 74"
